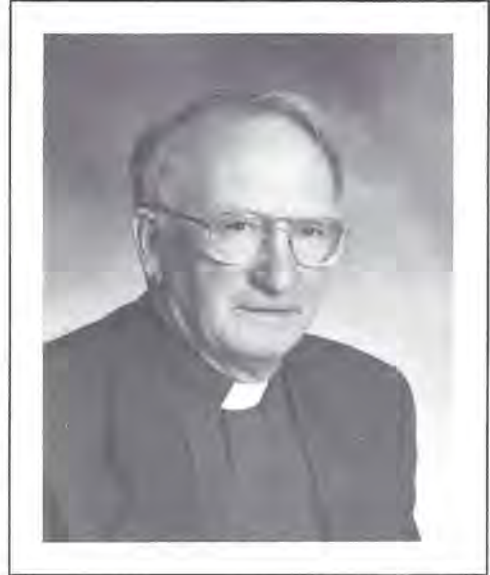

You have been wondering for a while, haven't you. Who are they? Well, wonder no more.



CARLOW UNITED CHURCH

After 1870 Carlow was served by Knox College Students' Missionary Society personnel, Messrs. Frizzel and Stewart the summer of 1871 and 72, Carmichael for 1873, Gilchrist for 1875. Their work was crowned with results and a burning desire in the hearts of Carlow's people for a church of their own. It was fanned by the resident ordained Elders, James Wilson and Robert Grant, appointed in 1868. When the latter left, music teacher Sylvanus Gemmel was elected by the congregation in 1873 and ordained after a show of hands from the congregation "in proof of their confirmation of the same on the Sacramental Sabbath, the 22nd day of August, 1875."

Rev. Wishart of Madoc negotiated purchase of a glebe of thirty acres for the congregation's use and in the winter of '73 and '74 preparations began for the new church's erection south of Boulter. According to Guy Wilson, lumber for this building was planed by hand by Walter Whitefoot, who charged a dollar for planning a thousand feet, and Thomas Wilson Sr., who passed away in 1916 at the age of 93, hewed the logs for its walls from pine felled at the top of Patterson's Mountain. Hewing the timbers for the church's foundation was Joseph Stringer. Raising the sided pine walls were William and Taylor Young, Dave Anderson, Tom Wilson (II), Andrew Whyte, Alex Wadsworth, Alec Stewart, John Stewart, George Grant and George McAllister.

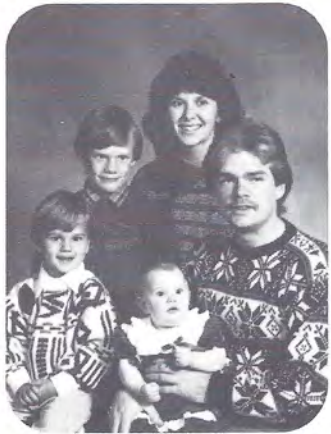
The experienced men supervising this important raising were James Wilson Sr., William Hynes, Peter Steward, John, William and Peter Stringer, William Parkhurst, Robert McLean Sr., Robert Wilson Sr., Alex Graham, James Storie, Duncan, William and Archie Campbell, James and Sam Adrian, Sylvanus Gemmel, William Davis and George Towns. They put on the roof, installed door and windows, floored it and plastered the chinks. Original seats were planks laid on sawed blocks and the first pulpit was a packing box.
